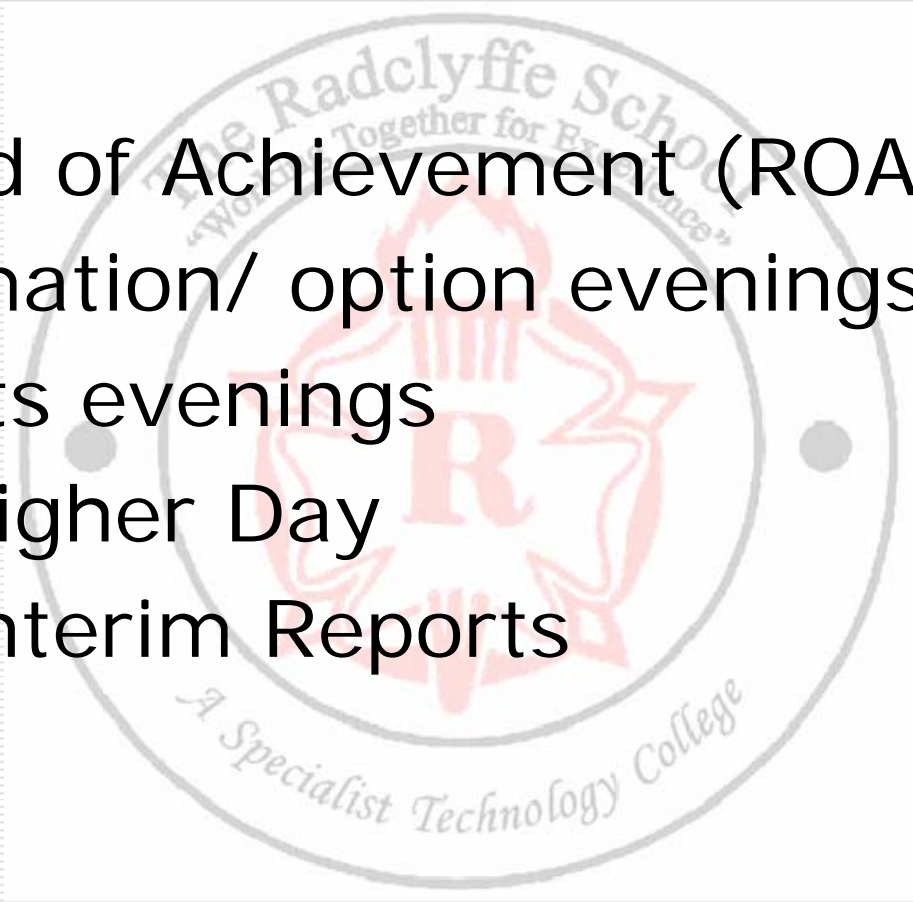

Problems with the current ROA system

- ❑ **Issued yearly** – it is a document that summarises a child's progress over a prolonged period. This provides parents very little opportunity for parents to respond to any issues it raises.
 - ❑ **4-5 weeks turn-around time** – due to the complexity of the collation of the document, a significant period of time can elapse between the date a teacher submits the comment, and it being received by the parent. This means the information can often be out of date.

Advantages of the proposed format

- ❑ Clear and easy to read
 - ❑ A clear indication of a student's 'Attitude to Learning'
 - ❑ Issued before information, option, and parents' evenings – this will allow parents to discuss any issues raised
 - ❑ Faster turn-around – the information will be more up-to-date
 - ❑ Issued at least once a term – this will allow parents to monitor their child's progress over a shorter time scale
