THE HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

PRINCIPLES

- ✓ We believe that students are most successful when parents and the school work together. A strong partnership between parents, students and the school will promote high standards for the students.
- ✓ Our aim is to provide the widest educational opportunity to all our students.
- ✓ We want every individual student to achieve their own personal excellence regardless of gender, culture or ability.
- ✓ Our school is a first class place of learning where all students feel happy and secure in a friendly working atmosphere.
- ✓ We help all students develop respect for others so that they can form tolerant and caring relationships and be sympathetic to the needs of other people.
- ✓ We aim to keep parents and students informed regarding their academic progress.
- ✓ We believe that regular attendance at school is vital if students are to make progress. We aim for this to be at least 95% for each individual. Parents have a legal responsibility to make sure that their child attends school.
- ✓ We believe that all students have individual needs that are catered for within a broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum. All students are fully integrated into the activities of the school but are given extra support when and where needed.
- ✓ We regard home learning as an essential part of students' education. It helps students to learn how to work independently and reinforces and extends the work in the classroom. It encourages good study habits. We rely on the help of parents to achieve this.
- ✓ We encourage students to develop self-discipline and a responsible attitude to other people and the environment. In order to achieve high standards of behaviour the school has a “Behaviour for Learning Policy” which helps students make positive choices about their behaviour.
- ✓ Anyone who signs this agreement can ask for a meeting regarding any aspect of this document.
- ✓ If your child breaks the Agreement by infringing the school code of conduct, they will be disciplined or excluded from school.

THE PARENTS / GUARDIANS
