Here are the different types of rewards you can get;

Reward trips

There are two reward trips every year, one at Christmas and one before the summer holidays.

To participate on one of these trips you need to have brilliant behaviour and good attendance.

You must have no negative entries or missed PEP4U on your events log and your attendance needs to be above 95%.

Commendations

Staff will log commendations for you if you have; good attitude to learning, good behaviour, or for; making progress in lessons and making a positive input to the school.

Year Managers will look at your commendations for the reward trip!

Postcards home

A Postcard home is a really good way of letting your parents know how well you are doing!

Staff will send postcards home for you, if you show progress in their lessons.

Postcards home can also be sent for good behaviour and good attitudes to learning.

Certificates

Your PLG will give you a certificate if you have 95% or better attendance or 100% attendance.

Subject teachers will give you a certificate if you achieve good marks.

You could be our star of the month and get a certificate with a £5 voucher! This is given by learning support if you show great attitude to learning and progress.

Merits and Prizes

If you have **100% attendance** your name goes into a draw and at the end of each week one student from each year will win **£5**.

For every **3 good pieces of work** you do, collect a **merit** by asking your teacher to sign your planner.
